

National Immunohematology Reference Laboratory Relocation

On April 1, 2020, the Canadian Blood Services National Immunohematology Reference Laboratory (NIRL) was relocated from Ottawa to the Brampton operations site.

NIRL continues to use highly sophisticated serological methods and molecular testing platforms to provide quality serological investigation, red cell genotype testing, medical consultation and assistance in finding the most suitable components for patients.

Diagnostic Services Ontario and Nunavut Laboratory still remains at the Brampton operations site and continues to provide the same level of referral testing and consultation services to Ontario hospital customers.
