Improving Red Blood Cell Utilization Customer Letter # 2020-40

Dear Colleagues:

We are very pleased to announce that Canadian Blood Services is collaborating with Choosing Wisely Canada in support of a pan-Canadian initiative to reduce the unnecessary transfusion of red blood cells.

Entitled <u>Using Blood Wisely</u> (www.usingbloodwisely.ca), the intention of this campaign is to challenge hospitals to benchmark themselves on appropriate transfusion practices.

Hospitals that choose to participate will be invited to conduct a spot audit of recent red blood cell transfusions in their hospital to see how they compare to national appropriateness benchmarks. All hospitals who meet benchmarks will be designated a Using Blood Wisely Hospital by Choosing Wisely Canada and Canadian Blood Services. Complete the spot audit by **December 1, 2020** and your hospital could be among the first to be recognized with this designation.
