Shelf Life Extension of Pooled Platelets Psoralen-Treated Components from 5 to 7 Days

Dear Colleagues:

Canadian Blood Services has received Health Canada approval to extend the shelf life of pooled platelets psoralen-treated (PPPT) from 5 days to 7 days. The implementation date is April 24, 2023.

Component codes will not change with 7-day platelets and, within the first week of implementation, hospitals receiving PPPT may receive a mixed inventory of platelets with a 5-day shelf life and a 7-day shelf life. Extra attention to PPPT expiry dates during this time may be required.

Please ensure that Laboratory Information Systems are configured to accept these components with the new 7-day shelf life starting the week of April 24, 2023.

As per Customer Letter <u>2022-34</u>, pending Health Canada approval, apheresis platelets psoralen-treated and apheresis platelets in PAS-E (platelet additive solution) are expected to implement with a 7-day shelf life.
