Update on Panzyga, Cutaquig and Octagam Availability

Dear Colleagues:

Further to <u>CL 2022-32</u>, Panzyga, Octagam, and Cutaquig were removed from the plasma protein and related products (PPRP) formulary in April 2023. Panzyga is no longer available for general ordering, and Canadian Blood Services is grateful to the hospital customers who are assisting with utilizing the remaining inventory.

Cutaquig and Octagam will continue to be available for general ordering until current inventory is depleted.

To prevent wastage, we are asking for your assistance in keeping patients on Cutaquig and Octagam until at least January 2024.

Cutaquig	Please begin transitions no earlier than January 2024. Transitions can then occur over a period of approximately six months.
Octagam	Please begin transitions no earlier than January 2024. Transitions can then occur over a period of approximately three months.

Please continue to monitor current and target share splits through the regular reports from your local hospital liaison specialist.
