## RHD Genotyping BC\_REF-08

## **TEST DESCRIPTION**

This is a PCR-based assay for the identification of many clinically significant RHD variants (alleles) responsible for normal and altered/absent expressions of the RhD human red cell antigen. This test is used to provide the predicted RhD status of a patient when it cannot be determined due to discrepant, weak or inconclusive serological RhD testing.

## SPECIMEN AND REQUISITION REQUIREMENTS

## Specimen(s)

- Minimum of one (1) 2-7 ml EDTA (lavender) tubes, mixed thoroughly by gentle agitation.
- Label specimen with the required minimum information: patient's last name, first name, PHN or unique identifier and date of collection.

## **Complete Requisition (must include)**

- · Patient's last name, first name, date of birth and PHN or unique identifier
- · Facility name, complete address, phone and fax number
- · Phlebotomist ID information
- · Date of collection

## Requisition(s)

- Request for RHD Genotyping Requisition\_AB
- Demande de génotypage RhD AB

## PRE-SHIPPING STORAGE

Recommended Refrigeration 1-10°C.

## SHIPPING INSTRUCTIONS

Submit samples as soon as possible after collection.

#### Shipping

- Ship in a container that will maintain temperature at ≥1°C.
- Select shipping method for container to arrive at testing site within 48 hours.

**Note:** Protect from freezing.
