Re: Responses to Health Canada Inspection of Licensed Activities at St. John's **Operations** 2022-07-25 to 2022-07-29

The following are the actions undertaken by Canadian Blood Services in response to the observations contained in the Health Canada Exit Notice dated 2022-08-16.

Section 39 – Donor Suitability Assessment

1. During the clinic date of 2022-01-20, for the two donors, Donor 5157739, C059022100883003 (platelets), and Donor 6557528, C059022100945007 (whole blood)

For question 06 "In the last 3 months have you had a vaccination?" the response was YES. The follow up, "Type of vaccination and/or vaccine brand name" was nondescriptly answered "booster". There are vaccinations as, defined in the DSCM, that present a reason for deferral. The two donors were accepted to donate.

During the inspection DEV-22-005568 was initiated.

A read and sign memo was created for all screening staff at the site to remind them of the documentation requirements for vaccine boosters. This was completed by 2022-08-23.

In addition, a communication will be sent to all collection sites, including St. John's, to remind all screening staff of the requirement to consult the DSCM for all vaccine types and the proper vaccination criteria documentation. This will be completed by 2022-10-28.
